Our August meeting is featuring a demo by Dennis Weber doing sculptures out of “paper clay.” This relatively new medium is a cross between ceramic clay and paper, dries extremely hard and can be fired or not, then finished with paint or innovative finishes.

Dennis is an artist of varied backgrounds. He studied the field of the visual arts and worked at department stores in visual display, which introduced him to the use of 3-D elements to create visual art. He eventually created his own business called D. W. Designs. He made display works and sets for Christmas displays in malls and hospitals on a large scale.
